For kids the \$50 entry fee includes both Kumite and Kata. All kids wishing to take part in the Kumite division are required to take part in the Kata division as well. Where a child only wishes to take part in kata then they are able to do so, however all kumite fighters must compete in kata.

Kata Divisions

In Round 1, competitors must perform the Mandatory Kata for their division.

Only a select number of competitors will move to the second round, where they will perform a kata of their choice from the kata list provided.

Kumite Divisions

Divisions are based on weight and you will be assigned to the appropriate category based on the weight that was entered in the application form. Weigh-in will be undertaken and where a significant difference is evident the tournament organiser reserves the right to change the competitor's division or where no options are available exclude the fighter from the tournament. Note, the tournament understands with growing children that this is a common occurrence and every effort will be made to ensure a suitable division is found.

Colts, Junior Colts and Kids will be grouped together based on experience and weight depending on entries received.

Juniors 5 – 6 years old

- under 60kg

Junior Colts 13 – 15 years old
Colts 16 – 17 years old
Adult Novice

Adult Senior (Over 40)

Adult Open Men intended weight divisions:

- under 70kg
- 70kg to 80kg
- 80kg to 90kg
- 90kg and over

Note: Every effort will be made to seed fighters to ensure that the draw is fair. This will be based on weight and experience. Depending on the number of entries received, matches may take the form of One-Match Challenges. The tournament organiser reserves the right to combine divisions if insufficient applications are received.

Kumite Rules

The tournament will be run under the 2022 International Kyokushin Organisation Competition Rules. The following modification will be in effect:

Rounds for Open Adult Divisions will be 3 minutes with maximum 2 x 2 minute extensions. In the final bout of each division, if no decision is clear after the second 2 minute extension, unlimited extensions of 2 minutes each shall continue until a decision is made.

Rounds for Novice Adult Divisions, Senior Adult Divisions and Colts will be 2 minutes with maximum 1 x 1.5 minute extensions. In the final bout of each division, if no decision is clear after the second 1.5 minute extension, unlimited extensions of 1 minute each shall continue until a decision is made.

Rounds for Juniors will be 1.5 minutes with maximum 2 x 1 minute extensions. In the final bout of each division, if no decision is clear after the second 1 minute extension, unlimited extensions of 1 minute each shall continue until a decision is made.

One Matches will be 3 x 2 minute rounds with a 1 minute break in between. Organisers may also choose to use 3 x 1.5 minute rounds where appropriate.

Protective Requirements

- Junior: Mouthguard, Shin and instep pads, Gloves, Headgear, Chest Protector
- Junior Colts: Mouthguard, Shin and instep pads, Gloves, Headgear, Chest Protector
- Colts: Mouthguard, Shin and instep pads, Gloves, Headgear
- Adult Novice: Mouthguard, Shin and instep pads
- Adult Senior: Mouthguard, Shin and instep pads
- Adult Open: Mouthguard

All Male fighters require groin guards and female adult fighters have the option of wearing a chest protector.
